

Topic: Aviation-Remote Controlled planes/Drones

Introduction:

- Think of a time when you were looking down on something from a high viewpoint.
- Imagine being able to fly in a drone on remote controlled airplane. What kind of things could you see?
- God does see everything even more so than if he were looking down from a remote controlled airplane or drone.

Application:

- Jeremiah 16:17- "My eyes are on all their ways; they are not hidden from me, nor is their sin concealed from my eyes." (Warning)
- Psalm 139- Speaks to a more comforting message of our Heavenly Father watching over us and knowing who we are.
 - This is a promise from God. Not to be taken as a warning to be sacred of, but to realize we cannot hide our sin from God. This can be also be understood in a good way when we read our next passage.
- Psalm 121:8- "the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."
 - As an eternal, omnipresent God, he can be with us at all times and look for us and keep us safe from all perils.
- Thinking of God as an omnipresent (everywhere at once) and all-knowing God can be intimidating sometimes because we are disgraced by what we do in secret. In reality, nothing is secret because God can look down and see everything we say, think, and do. He also can protect us from all harm that he sees coming our way. God leads us through a path of life that we must trust because he can see what will be best for us in the end. It is like God is looking down on a map of our lives and he can see all the end results and we can only see what is right in front of us.

Prayer:

- Dear Heavenly Father, you truly know and see all. Thank you for constantly watching over us and guarding us from evil. Please give us the knowledge to recognize our sin and repent because we know you see all the sin we commit. Thank you for sending our Savior from sin Jesus Christ and in his name we pray. Amen.
