

Guidelines and rules for Family Adventure Days

As your hosts for this event, Lutheran Pioneers, Inc. must make a few demands and set some important rules and guidelines. Some are listed here in general terms, and others will be made more specific at the event. See also Page two for some more important information!

BB Guns - Although we will have bb guns and bb's there, you may bring your own, but it may only be used on the designated range and only at the appointed times.

Bows and Arrows - Although we will bow and arrows there, you may bring your own, but it may only be used on the designated range and only at the appointed times. Practice tips only - NO BROAD-HEADS

Wrist Rockets - Although we will have wrist rockets and associated ammunition there, you may bring your own, but it may only be used on the designated range and only at the appointed times.

.22 Caliber rifles - Although we will have them there, you may bring your own, but it may only be used on the designated range and only at the appointed times, and only under the direction of our designated range instructor. Must be locked in your vehicle when not in use. Only adults may transport to and from the range. 22 long rifle ammunition will not be supplied, you must either bring your own, or purchase it on site from us. **Pistols** - NO PISTOLS ALLOWED

Photographs - Of course you may take all the pictures you like. We will be taking photographs throughout the event. As part of your registration, you will be signing a release authorizing Lutheran Pioneers to use these photographs on our website, mass mailings, and promotional materials. We intend to take photographs of families as well. All photographs will be uploaded to the website for you to download and keep.

Alcoholic Beverages - Although alcoholic beverages are permitted; we require that you be responsible and respectful. Adult beverages will not be permitted at some of the activities. These areas will be posted as such. No one under the influence will be permitted on the rifle range area.

The Pond (Lake) - This pond is not large, but is nonetheless dangerous. Although much effort has been put into installing aerators and repairing the dam; the water levels and presence of weeds are subject to the weather in the months preceding the event. **Canoes and boats** are available onsite and may be used ONLY with proper life jackets or life vests. **Swimming** is "at your own risk". There is no lifeguard on duty. Small children must be accompanied by an adult. **Fishing** is allowed, but purely on a catch and release basis. No fish may be kept.

Overall Responsibility - Lutheran Pioneers is hosting this event on the premises of Pineridge Camp. It is a family event, and as such, the family is responsible in much the same way as if you were attending a public event of another kind. You are responsible for your own personal property. You are responsible to ensure that those entrusted to your care are adequately supervised, when necessary, and participate in only those activities for which you have given them permission. Although parental supervision may or may not be required at individual activities, minors may not attend the event without a responsible adult.

Guidelines and rules for Family Adventure Days

Dress Code - No wearing of clothing that contains offensive, suggestive, or political content.

Squirt Gun Tie-Dyeing – We will be supplying the squirt guns and the dye. Those who wish to participate MUST bring their own T-shirt or other white item to tie-dye.

Safety and scheduling of activities –

Lutheran Pioneers has been planning this event for a very long time. We will do our best to accommodate participation by all. However, some activities may overlap, others may be off limits at certain times due to safety concerns. For example, a part of the disc golf course uses a part of the 3D Archery Course. We can't have disc golfers running out in front of bow and arrows. We plan to have a daily "compass" or "schedule of events" on site to make these items clear.

Weather considerations: This is an outdoor event. We will do our best to hold activities rain or shine, by moving this under shelter or indoors if possible. Some things are out of our control. For example, if on Thursday we already know that the Rock Climbing wall will be a rainout, we will try move that event to Friday if weather on Friday permits. However, the vendor of the Rock Climbing wall gets to make that decision.

ABOVE ALL –

Remember that the purpose of this event is to have fun, fellowship and worship with your Christian brothers and sisters in God's wonderful creation. Respect each other. Respect the facilities and equipment.
